Local Advocacy

Provide effective local advocacy for member clinics that results in stronger delivery system relationships and investments.

- **The Remaining Uninsured:** Represent members in county-based advocacy to support access to care for remaining uninsured residents, especially in the areas of prevention and primary care
- **County and Other Local Investments in the Safety-Net:** Effectively advocate for enhanced funding and investment in community clinics to support capacity building and increased prevention, primary care, dental care, and behavioral health services
- **Medi-Cal Managed Care Advocacy:** Lead coordinated health plan education and advocacy around key local Medi-Cal managed care issues, such as network adequacy and access to specialty care and mental health services
- **Access:** Improve access to all health services for both insured and uninsured low-income residents of our communities
- **Community Engagement:** Inform, educate and activate clients and community-based organizations to speak out on issues related to access to care in our communities

- Increased access to coverage and care
- Inclusion of members in county-wide planning initiatives and funding opportunities

Value-Based Care Transformation

Elevate recognition of members as valuable providers, employers, and partners in their local communities

- **Transformation Initiatives:** Facilitate the inclusion of and funding for members in county initiatives, such as whole person care pilots, dental transformation initiatives, and other 1115 waiver initiatives, Accountable Communities for Health and others
- **Medi-Cal Managed Care Payments/Contracts:** Coordinate county-specific advocacy and planning to increase managed care funding for members and explore with Contra Costa Health Plan and Partnership HealthPlan of California how to maximize health center reimbursement including risk-based contracting
- **Social Determinants of Health:** Facilitate participation of members in community collaborations and projects that address social determinants of health including effective approaches to data collection and reporting on SDOH

- Improved coordination of health care among health delivery systems

Delivery System Collaboration

Strengthen current and build new service partnerships and collaborations that enhance delivery system integration among health centers, hospitals, and county health services

- **Hospital Partnerships:** Facilitate new service partnerships between area hospitals and members
- **Health Plan Partnerships:** Support efforts with Medi-Cal managed care plans to develop a coordinated health care workforce strategy
- **Community Pipeline Partnerships:** Support community-wide strategies to build the health care workforce through cultivation of community partnerships, including school/residency partnerships, recruitment partnerships, and other strategies
- **Health Data Sharing Opportunities:** Represent and connect members to county planning projects that advance data sharing efforts among local hospitals, health plans, and other providers
- **Health Center Capacity:** Support access to coverage and care through the provision of training and technical assistance, including enrollment, retention, and other relevant initiatives

- Increased member capacity to support patients and employees
- Adoption of Consortium sustainability plan by CCC Board

Consortia Infrastructure

Strengthen CCC infrastructure to ensure long term financial sustainability

- **Financing:** Explore new grant and other financing approaches to sustain the consortium
- **Consortia Partnerships:** Enhance strategic business partnerships with other consortia (RCHC, AHC)
- **Staffing:** Maintain effective staffing levels to implement priorities and strategies and take advantage of new opportunities
